



Visiting Home Safety Norms

Boarders and Parents must comply with the following guidelines to ensure safety of the Boarders:

- The Boarders will be sent on local exeat / holiday only with the parents or local guardians as recorded in the Boarder's Profile Form. Any local exeat or holiday will be permitted after "out Pass" is made. No Boarder will be allowed to leave Hostel for home after Sun-set.
- Separate authority letter will be required if the Boarder is to be sent alone or with any other person not registered in our records.
- 3. The House Master is empowered to grant leave to boarders on exeat days. Leave in exceptional cases including emergencies can be granted by the Principal.
- Parents are expected to plan their visit to the hostel on local exeat or holiday of their wards as per the calendar and schedule. Extension of leave already scheduled will not be considered in any case.
- To maintain discipline in the school /hostel parents must ensure that ward report back at the hostel before the schedule time after every holiday /vacation before Sun-set. After Sun-set no boarder will be received.
- 6. Parents are advised to follow the given schedule to avoid any inconvenience.

Guidelines for the Parents Admitting their wards in Boarding House

Reporting Precautions

Parents are advised to take the following precautions at the time of reporting to avoid any inconvenience.

- 1. While reporting to the hostel, 1st Term Fee Deposit Receipt should be presented.
- Parent must deposit the "Boarder's Profile From" duly filled in at the time of admitting their ward in the hostel
 - (A certificate of fitness certified by a Doctor not below than M.B.B.S. is required)
- Parents and local guardians must sign the Boarder's Profile Form and provide their recent pass-port size photographs for future identification.
- 4. Parent must ensure that the child carries all the items as mentioned in the prospectus or in the list provided by the school along with the prescribed set of text books and note-books etc.
- 5. No eatables are allowed in the School/Boarding House.
- Parent are advised and requested not to give any valuable items like, Gold / Silver items , Camera ,
 Mobile and any other electronic items to the ward, such articles if found will be confiscated. Keeping
 or using mobile in Hostel is strictly prohibited.
- Patents are requested not to give any cash to the ward as his requirements will be met from "Pocket Money"
- Parents are also requested to submit authority letter if their wards are to be sent alone or with any other person not registered in our records.



Code of Conduct for Boarders

Patwa Academy also provides boarding facility to its students based on the concept a Home away home. The boarders residing in boarding house are expected to follow the Code of Conduct for the Boarders.

They are expected to stay within the designated school campus. They have to comply with the following Rules and Regulations during their stay on School Campus or in Boarding House.

- (i) They are not allowed to have money in their possession. Money Transaction and exchanging of gifts is not allowed in the Hostel. If they have any money, they are advised to handover it to the House Master. Any money found in their possession will be confiscated.
- (ii) No Boarder will be allowed to night—stay outside of the Hostel and to leave the boarding house to go to home alone on the occasion of Holidays or Sunday. Separate authority letter is required if boarder is to be sent alone
- (iii) Keeping mobile or any other electronic and electrical item is not allowed. Any violation of these rules will attract penalties and the items will be confiscated.
- (iv) No boarder will visit the areas out of bounds like Swimming Pool, Well, Terrace, Staff Quarters etc. If any boarder found violating this rules will be dealt with seriously.
- (v) Breaking switch boards, damaging property will be treated as an offence and offence of such nature will be considered seriously and will be dealt with seriously. Boarders may be asked to vacate the boarding house at once.
- (vi) If any boarder indulges himself in the tempering or breaking switch boards and at the time of doing so he is hurt or anything happened to him, he himself will be responsible for this untoward incident. School administration will not be responsible under any circumstance for such incident.
- (vii) Boarders will set an example of discipline in the Hostel, School, Play ground, Dining Hall, Common Room, even when not supervised.
- (viii) There are no space for use of obscene language and any act of bullying in our system. Offenses of such nature are considered serious and there is zero tolerance for this and boarder may be asked to vacate the boarding house at once.
- (ix) All the boarders shall maintain cleanliness in the Hostel. They are expected to keep their rooms/ dorms and their surrounding neat, clean and tidy.
- (x) All the boarders are requested to participate in the daily routine as indicated in school calendar. Prior permission by the relevant authority is required for any kind of absence.
- (xi) The possession and consumption of alcohol and tobacco by students will be treated as immediate expulsion.
- (xii) Boarders may not lock doors from the inside when in the room/dorm. Indecent and offensive posters are also not allowed.
- (xiii) The school authorities have the right to conduct searches and check the belonging of students any time or moment.
- (xiv) The purpose of the code of conduct for the boarders is to ensure high safety standard and personal growth of students. The main objective of this policy is to help boarders reflect, take responsibility and change behavior.
- (xv) No boarder will hide any ailment/ diseases at the time of admission. If later on school administration comes to know about such diseases his admission will be cancelled.
- (xvi) Every boarder has to produces medical certificate of fitness by the registered Medical Officer at the time of admission

Principal

Co-Curricular Activities:

Admission Procedure:

- A photocopy of Birth Certificate as a proof of age is to be submitted for admission in Pre-Primary Classes.
- Transfer Certificate, Photocopy of Mark sheet of previous school are to be submitted for admission Class I onwards at the time of admission.
- Medical Certificate is also required from a Govt. Hospital or from a recognized Clinic declaring the Health Status of the child.

Withdrawal:

- 1. Application for withdrawal is to be made which is to be addressed to the Principal.
- One Month's notice period is required for withdrawal.
- 3. Clearance certificate is required from various departments before the withdrawal.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued after one week from the date of withdrawal.



Leave Rules:

- 1. No leave of absence is granted without the prior permission of the Principal
- For any leave of absence, proper leave application addressed to the Principal must be submitted in writing by the Parent.
- 3. Students are not allowed to leave the school during school hours. Leave for half a day is not permitted.
